英語英文学研究とコンピュータ・ネットワーク ——World Wide Web の利用を中心に——

インターネットをはじめとする世界的なコンピュータ・ネットワークの発達と、ネットワークを介して提供される情報量の増大によって、研究に必要な情報収集の効率と速度が高まっている。文学研究・語学研究もその例外ではない。コンピュータ・ネットワークは、米国では60年代末に大学間ネットワークの萌芽を見た。日本においては、80年代初頭から図書館書誌目録のオンライン化が開始され、80年代末からは書誌情報がネットワーク経由で提供されるようになった。また、商用データベースにより新聞雑誌のフルテキストの供給も開始された。その後90年代に入り、コンピュータ・ネットワークは学術・商用ネットワークともに、利用人口とサービスの内容において急速に発達し、現在は、回線の高速化とパーソナル・コンピュータの処理能力の向上によって、画像や音声を取り入れたハイパーテキストを送受信するコンピュータ通信が一般化している。WWW (World Wide Web) という通信手段がそれである。

WWW はインターネット上で、HTTP (Hyper Text Transfer Protocol) と呼ばれる通信手段を用いて、サーバ・クライアントシステムによって情報を提供する情報検索システムである。提供される情報は HTML (Hyper Text Mark-up Language) と呼ばれる言語によって記述される。HTML は、デジタル化された文字、音声、静止画像、動画像を自由に提示できるハイパーテキストを作成できる記述言語である。HTML の中からは、リンク付けすることによって、当該サーバばかりでなく、インターネット上のあらゆる情報資産にアク

セスし提示することができる。この際、情報はまず紙のメタファを用いて、ディスプレイ上に文字と画像で表示されるドキュメント（画面）として作成される。音声や動画像などは、ドキュメントの中からリンクさせて呼び出すことによって、スピーカーやディスプレイ上に再生される。

個々の WWW 情報サーバの入り口となるドキュメントはホーム・ページ (Home Page) と呼ばれる。完成されたドキュメントは提供側のサーバを介して、主としてインターネットを通じて供給され、ユーザはインターネットに接続する最寄りの端末機から、ブラウザと呼ばれるインターフェース・ソフトウェアを利用して目指すサイト（情報サーバ）に接続し、これを閲覧する。ディスプレイ上に表示されたドキュメントのリンク付けされた情報源をマウスクリックすることで、リンクされた文書や画像を閲覧したり、さらに他の情報源にアクセスすることができる。米国の NCSA (National Center for Supercomputing Applications) が 1993 年に Mosaic と呼ばれるブラウザ・ソフトウェアを開発し、無償で提供して以来、WWW を利用した様々な情報サービスが急速に発展してきている。学術研究に資するネットワーク資産も次々と WWW によって提供されるようになっていく。

人文系の研究領域におけるネットワーク利用は、欧米では早くからその重要性が認められてきているが、日本では最近になってようやく認識され始めた段階である¹⁾。筆者は 1990 年から本格的に学術コンピュータ・ネットワークを利用しはじめ、現在まで様々なインターフェースとオペレーティングシステムの変遷を経験した。この間、当初は理系の一部研究者のものであったネットワークが、人文系研究者にも利用するに足るものに発展してきた過程を見守ってきた。ネットワークの基本的な利用法に関しては、別稿で扱ったので、ここでは英語英文学研究に有用な WWW サイトのうち注目すべきものを精選し、必要に応じて注釈をほどこした²⁾。






